BAPTISM:

The sacrament of Baptism (English, Polish) is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th weekends of the month. Because our parish family is welcoming a new member to our faith community, Baptisms will be celebrated during the following Masses: 5PM Saturday vigil Mass in English, 9:30AM Polish Mass, or 11AM Mass in English. There will be no private Baptisms. Those chosen as Godparents must be practicing, Confirmed Catholics whose lives reflect a commitment to the Catholic faith and to the role of Godparent. In order to receive a Sponsorship Certificate required by all Godparents, prospective Godmothers and Godfathers must be registered and supporting parishioners of Saint Ladislaus Church. Parents must register their child prior to the Baptism. Parents of first children are required to receive instruction. The sacrament of Baptism (Spanish) is celebrated during the 4PM Mass on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month. Guidelines for pre-Baptismal registration and instruction are the same for all Baptisms.

MARRIAGES: Arrange *at least* six months before the date.





Important news that we have received from the Diocese of Rockville Centre:

From the beginning of the Coronavirus pandemic, the Diocese of Rockville Centre has granted Catholics a dispensation from attending Mass in person. Throughout this prolonged period, we have been fortunate to have access to Mass through a livestream transmission. We are grateful to Father Mariusz for making the streaming of Mass possible so soon after learning that our church doors would be closed because of the Covid crisis. Many of our own parishioners and worshippers from other churches have taken advantage of our livestream. We have had access to not only one Mass each weekend, but to all weekend and weekday Masses. Because we have been moving closer to normalcy due to the vaccines and the various precautions that have been adopted, the dispensation from attending Mass in person will soon be discontinued. Please note that beginning the weekend of August 14th and 15th of this year (the weekend of the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary), Catholics are to return to Mass in person. The livestream option will remain for those who cannot come to the church because of advanced age or illness.

*Also note that the wearing of the masks will become recommended, but not obligatory. The Offertory procession of bringing up the Gifts has not been resumed as of yet.

Your compliance with all of the restrictions that we have undergone because of the virus is admirable and most appreciated. We anticipate your usual cooperation as we move forward.
