BAPTISM:

The sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on weekends. Baptisms will be celebrated *during* the following Masses: 5PM Saturday Vigil Mass (Eng.), Sunday 8AM (Eng.) 9:30AM(Polish), or 4PM (Spanish). (*Note:* Baptisms during the 4PM Spanish Mass are celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month.) Parents who want to arrange a Baptism need to come to the rectory office and provide the child's birth certificate. Parents of first children are required to receive instruction prior to the baptism. Those chosen as Godparents must be practicing, Confirmed Catholics whose lives reflect a commitment to the Catholic faith and to the role of Godparent. All Godparents need to obtain a document of sponsorship from the parish *where they are registered members*.

MARRIAGES: Arrange *at least* six months before the date.

DEVOTIONS:

May: Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary after each Sunday Mass

October: Decade of the Rosary after Sunday Masses

Lent: Stations of the Cross every Friday after the 7:30 AM Mass in English; 7:30 PM in Polish.

Gorzkie Żale on Sundays in Lent following the 9:30 AM Polish Mass.

For World Youth Day~ We pray that the World Youth Day in Lisbon will help young people to live and witness the Gospel in their own lives.



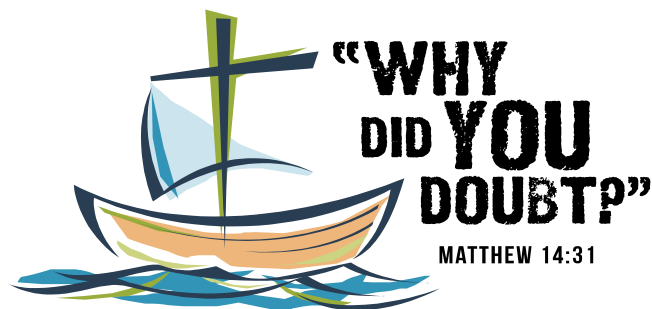
Saving Lord, grant that we, Your faithful, ever incline an open ear to hear You speak to us. Give us the strength to shut out the noisy distractions of the world that capture our

Saint Maximilian Kolbe was a Polish Catholic priest who died a martyr. While imprisoned at the Auschwitz concentration camp, he volunteered to take the place of a stranger who was about to be killed. He was known as the “Apostle of Consecration to Mary” because of his lifelong devotion to the veneration of the Blessed Mother.
