

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today we celebrate the solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul, who were basic for the early Church and, therefore, for our Christian faith. Apostles of the Lord, witnesses of the first hour, they lived those initial moments of expansion of the Church and sealed with their blood their loyalty to Jesus. If only we, Christians of the 21st century, also know how to be reliable witnesses of the love of God in the midst of men, as these two Apostles were, along with so many others of our fellow citizens.

In one of his first interventions addressing the Cardinals, Pope Francis told them that we must 'walk, build and confess'. That is, we must move forward in our way of life, by building up our Church and by giving testimony of the Lord. But the Pope warned: "We can walk as much as we want, we can build many things, but if we do not profess Jesus Christ, things go wrong. We may become a charitable NGO, but not the Church, the Bride of the Lord."

We have heard in the Mass Gospel a central fact for the life of Peter and the Church. Jesus asks that fisherman of Galilee an act of faith in his divine status and Peter does not hesitate to say: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." (Mt 16:16). Jesus institutes the Primacy immediately by telling Peter that he will be the firm rock upon which the Church, throughout the ages, will be built (cf. Mt 16:18) and by giving him the power of the keys of the Kingdom, the Supreme authority.

Although Peter and his successors are assisted by the force of the Holy Spirit, they still need our prayers, because their mission is of great significance for the life of the Church: they must be a strong foundation for all Christians throughout the ages; we must, therefore, also pray, every day, for the Holy Father, for his person and for his intentions.

CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Why are the reports about Jesus called "the Gospel", "the Good News"?

Without the Gospels we would not know that God sends his Son to us men out of his infinite love, so that despite our sins we might find our way back to eternal fellowship with God. The reports about the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus are the best news in the world. They testify that the Jew who was born in Bethlehem, Jesus of Nazareth, is "Son of the living God" (Mt 16:16) made man. He was sent by the Father so that "all men might be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth."

KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO

Grzech pierwородny? Co mamy wspólnego z upadkiem Adama i Ewy? Grzech we właściwym sensie jest ponoszona osobiście winą. Wyrażenie „grzech pierwородny” nie oznacza osobistego grzechu, lecz kondycję ludzką pozbawioną pierwotnej świętości i sprawiedliwości, z jaką rodzi się każdy człowiek, zanim jeszcze zgrzeszy z własnej woli. Odnośnie do grzechu pierwородnego, mówi Benedykt XVI, należy wiedzieć, „że wszyscy nosimy w sobie kroplę trucizny tego myślenia, które zostaje obrazowo przedstawił w KSIĘDZE RODZAJU (...) Człowiek nie ufa Bogu. Skuszony słowami węża, podejrzewa, że (...) Bóg jest konkurentem, który ogranicza naszą wolność, i że dopiero wtedy jesteśmy w pełni ludźmi, gdy odstawimy Boga na dalszy plan (...) Człowiek nie chce swojego istnienia i pełni życia otrzymywać od Boga (...) I przez to, że tak czyni, zawiera się w kłamstwu zamiast prawdzie i tym samym opiera swoje życie na pustce, na śmierci” (Benedykt XVI, 8.12.2005)

ROZWAŻANIE NA NIEDZIELE

Dzisiejszy dzień poświęcony jest męczeństwu Apostołów Piotra i Pawła. «Piotr, pierwszy głosiciel wiary; Paweł, oświecony nauczyciel prawdy» Dziś jest dzień, w którym powinniśmy dziękować za apostołską wiarę, która jest również naszą wiarą ogłoszoną przez te dwie kolumny w kazaniach. To wiara, która zwycięża świat, bo głosi, że Jezus jest Synem Boga: «Ty jesteś Mesjasz, Syn Boga żywego» (Mt 16,16). Pozostałe święta apostołów Piotra i Pawła skupiają się na innych kwestiach, ale dzisiaj rozważamy to, co pozwala nazwać ich «pierwszymi głosicielami Ewangelii»: swym męczeństwem potwierdzili swe świadectwo.

Ich wiara i siła w męczeństwie nie pochodziły z ludzkiej kondycji. To nie był człowiek z krwi i kości, który podpowiedział Piotrowi kim był Jezus, ale objawienie Ojca Niebieskiego (por. Mt 16,17). Tak czy inaczej uznanie “tego którego szukał” za Jezusa Pana było dla Szawła oczywistym dziełem łaski Bożej. W obu przypadkach wolność ludzka, która domaga się aktu wiary spoczywa w działaniu Ducha.

Wiara apostołów jest wiarą Kościoła, jedynego, świętego, powszechnego i apostołskiego. Od wyznania Piotra w Cezarei Filipowej «każdego dnia w Kościele Piotr kontynuuje mówiąc: ‘Ty jesteś Mesjasz, Syn Boga żywego!’» (Leon I Wielki). Od tego czasu aż po dziś tłumy chrześcijan z każdej epoki, w każdym wieku, z każdej kultury i jakiegokolwiek innej miary, która odróżnia ludzi, jednogłośnie głosili zwycięską wiarę.

Przez chrzest i bierzmowanie wprowadzeni zostajemy na drogę świadectwa, to znaczy męczeństwa. Musimy uważać na “laboratorium wiary”, które Duch realizuje w nas (Jan Paweł II) i pokornie prosić, byśmy doświadczyli radości wiary Kościoła.

COMUNIDAD HISPANO

REFLEXIONES DEL *EVANGELIO*

Hoy, celebramos la solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo, los cuales fueron fundamentos de la Iglesia primitiva y, por tanto, de nuestra fe cristiana. Apóstoles del Señor, testigos de la primera hora, vivieron aquellos momentos iniciales de expansión de la Iglesia y sellaron con su sangre la fidelidad a Jesús. Ojalá que nosotros, cristianos del siglo XXI, sepamos ser testigos creíbles del amor de Dios en medio de los hombres tal como lo fueron los dos Apóstoles y como lo han sido tantos y tantos de nuestros conciudadanos.

En una de las primeras intervenciones del Papa Francisco, dirigiéndose a los cardenales, les dijo que hemos de «caminar, edificar y confesar». Es decir, hemos de avanzar en nuestro camino de la vida, edificando a la Iglesia y confesando al Señor. El Papa advirtió: «Podemos caminar tanto como queramos, podemos edificar muchas cosas, pero si no confesamos a Jesucristo, alguna cosa no funciona. Acabaremos siendo una ONG asistencial, pero no la Iglesia, esposa del Señor».

Hemos escuchado en el Evangelio de la misa un hecho central para la vida de Pedro y de la Iglesia. Jesús pide a aquel pescador de Galilea un acto de fe en su condición divina y Pedro no duda en afirmar: «Tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios vivo» (Mt 16,16). Inmediatamente, Jesús instituye el Primado, diciendo a Pedro que será la roca firme sobre la cual se edificará la Iglesia a lo largo de los tiempos (cf. Mt 16,18) y dándole el poder de las llaves, la potestad suprema.

Aunque Pedro y sus sucesores están asistidos por la fuerza del Espíritu Santo, necesitan igualmente de nuestra oración, porque la misión que tienen es de gran trascendencia para la vida de la Iglesia: han de ser fundamento seguro para todos los cristianos a lo largo de los tiempos; por tanto, cada día nosotros hemos de rezar también por el Santo Padre, por su persona y por sus intenciones.

New York Blood Center Blood Emergency Talking Points for the Diocese of Rockville Centre- Updated June 2025. Blood Emergency

On June 2, 2025, New York Blood Center (NYBC) declared a blood emergency following a sharp and sustained drop in local blood donations. Only 2% of New Yorkers donate blood. Warmer months bring an increase in accidents and trauma-related injuries. Known as "trauma season," late spring and summer see a rise in emergency room visits and transfusion needs. At the same time, blood donations typically decline due to travel, school breaks, and holiday schedules, creating a dire need. • June projections show that 5,000 additional donations are urgently needed, requiring more than 100 new blood drives to be scheduled in the coming weeks.

About the Diocese of Rockville Centre Blood Donation Campaign • The Diocese of Rockville Centre contributed nearly 7,000 lifesaving blood donations in 2024 affecting the lives of nearly 21,000 patients in need. • NYBC is fortunate to count on the support of more than 60 parishes that sponsor blood drives regularly within the diocese, averaging nearly 60 donations per event. •

NYBC has served the tri-state area for more than 60 years, delivering more than 1,500 units of life-saving blood products each day to 200+ hospitals in the region. • Individuals who require blood transfusions include cancer patients, accident, burn, or trauma victims, laboring mothers and newborn babies, transplant recipients, surgery patients, chronically transfused patients suffering from sickle cell disease or thalassemia, and more.

Donations from younger generations are becoming increasingly vital, as the share of blood donors under the age of 30 has declined by more than 30% in recent years.
