
Today, Sunday, November 3, is the day on which we commemorate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the cathedral of the Holy Father, who is the Bishop of Rome. It is the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome, and is therefore the principal church of the Pontiff, not St. Peter's, as is commonly thought. Because we, the people of God, make up the Church, the Lateran Basilica is indeed our spiritual home.

PRAYER OF THE WEEK


