Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the Good Samaritan. Jesus uses this parable to answer the question posed by the scholar, "Who is my neighbor?" It is interesting to note that prior to this question, the scholar had stated that we are to love God with all of our being and also love our neighbor as ourselves.
