Called to evangelize...

This past Tuesday was the feast day of St. Joseph, foster-father of Jesus. Despite the lack of recorded dialogue in the Gospels, St. Joseph teaches us many things. Foremost, this saint trusted God—simply, joyfully, wholeheartedly—in marrying Mary, in naming Jesus, in shepherding the precious pair to Egypt, in bringing them to Nazareth. Throughout the undetermined number of years of quiet faith and courage, Joseph *trusted*.

Do you practice such trust? You may have a satisfying job, enjoy good health, and seemingly have everything under control. What happens when the storms come? Do you put your trust only in yourself? Do you escape to unhealthy activities to help ease the pain?

St. Joseph also faced huge problems but carried out his vocation with complete fidelity. He patiently taught his foster son to practice his Jewish faith, passed on its laws and customs, and helped Him learn his carpentry trade. He was a *conscientious* steward...of his traditions, his vocation, and his relationships.
