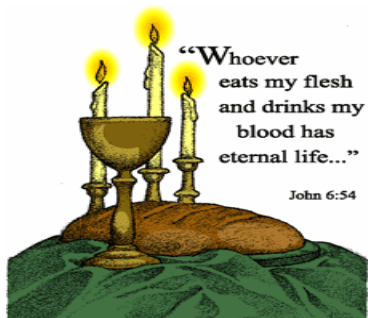

 experience by maintaining  
 silence throughout the Liturgy of  
 the Eucharist?
