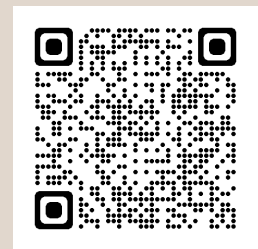

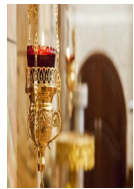


NEW WEEKLY MEMORIALS

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday. First and foremost, the attitude of the sheep must be to listen to the shepherd's voice and follow him. To listen carefully, to be docile to his word, to follow him with a decision that engages the whole existence: understanding, heart, all strength and all action, following in His footsteps.

For his part, Jesus, the Good Shepherd, knows his sheep and gives them eternal life, in such a way that they will never be lost and, furthermore, no one will take them from his hand. Christ is the true Good Shepherd who gave his life for the sheep (cf. Jn 10:11), for us, sacrificing himself on the cross. He knows His sheep and His sheep know Him, just as the Father knows Him and He knows the Father. It is not about a superficial and external knowledge, nor just an intellectual knowledge. It is about a deep personal relationship, an integral knowledge of the heart, which ends up becoming friendship, because this is the logical consequence of a relationship between one who loves and one who is loved; in whom you know you can fully trust.

It is God the Father who has entrusted him with the care of his sheep. Everything is the fruit of the love of God the Father given to his Son Jesus Christ. Jesus fulfills the mission that his Father has entrusted to him, which is the care of his sheep, with a fidelity that will not allow anyone to take them from his hand, with a love that leads him to give his life for them, in communion with the Father because "The Father and I are one" (Jn 10:30).

CATECHISM *of the* CATHOLIC CHURCH

With Jesus Christ, has everything been said, or does revelation continue even after him? In Jesus Christ, God himself came to earth. He is God's last Word. By listening to him, all men of all times can know who God is and what is necessary for their salvation. [66-67] With the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the →REVELATION of God is perfect and complete. To make it comprehensible to us, the Holy Spirit leads us ever deeper into the truth. God's light breaks so forcefully into the lives of many individuals that they "see the heavens opened" (Acts 7:56). That is how the great places of pilgrimage such as Guadalupe in Mexico or Lourdes in France came about. The "private revelations" of visionaries cannot improve on the Gospel of Jesus Christ. No one is obliged to believe in them. But they can help us understand the Gospel better. Their authenticity is tested by the →CHURCH. INCARNATION (from the Latin caro, carnis = flesh, "becoming flesh"): God's act of becoming man in Jesus Christ. This is the foundation of Christian faith and of hope for the redemption of mankind. In many and various ways God spoke of old to our fathers by the prophets; but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son. Heb 1:1-2 Apart from Jesus Christ we do not know what God, life, death, and we ourselves are.



We offer heartfelt prayers for the sick, those suffering physical or mental weakness, the lonely, the hungry, the isolated, the homeless. We remember to pray for those living in war-torn countries. We pray for the safety of those serving in our military.

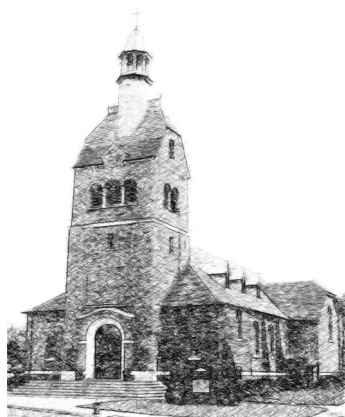

APOSTOLAT POLSKI

ZAREJESTRUJ SIĘ DO NASZEJ PARAFII

Serdecznie witamy nowych członków parafii i zapraszamy do rejestracji w Biurze Parafialnym. Rejestracji w kościele św. Władysława można dokonać pobierając formularze w sekretariacie lub przy wejściu do kościoła. Wypełniony formularz można przesłać pocztą na plebanię, wrzucić do koszyka lub dostarczyć osobiście do Biura Parafialnego. Jedną z najważniejszych rzeczy, którą powinni zrobić mieszkańcy parafii, jest rejestracja. Rejestracja w parafii nie tylko czyni Cię bardziej częścią rodziny kościoła św. Władysława ale także daje Tobie i Twojej rodzinie szansę na bycie usłyszonym w parafii.



KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO

Czy w Jezusie Chrystusie wszystko zostało już powiedziane, czy też po Nim Objawienie nadal będzie trwało? W Jezusie Chrystusie sam Bóg przyszedł na świat. On jest ostatnim Słowem Boga. Wsłuchując się w Niego, wszyscy ludzie wszystkich czasów mogą poznać, kim jest Bóg i co jest niezbędne dla ich zbawienia. W Ewangelii Jezusa Chrystusa -> **OBJAWIENIE** Boże osiąga całkowitą pełnię. Żeby ono nas oświeciło, Duch Święty prowadzi nas coraz głębiej ku prawdzie. W życie niektórych ludzi światło Boże wpada tak mocno, że wi dzą „niebo otwarte”. W ten sposób powstały wielkie ośrodki pielgrzymkowe jak Guadalupe w Meksyku czy Lourdes we Francji. „Prywatne objawienia” doznawane przez wizjonerów nie mogą w niczym ulepszyć Ewangelii Jezusa Chrystusa. Nie mają powagi objawienia publicznego. Mogą jednakże pomóc nam lepiej zrozumieć Ewangelię. Ich autentyczność jest weryfikowana przez KOŚCIÓŁ.

ROZWAŻANIE NA NIEDZIELE

Dzisiaj Jezus mówi nam: ”Ja jestem dobrym pasterzem” (J 10,11). Święty Tomasz z Akwinu komentując owo stwierdzenie, pisze, iż “wydaje się oczywiste, że tytuł pasterza pasuje do Chrystusa. Bo podobnie jak pasterz prowadzi paść swoje owce, tak Chrystus posila wiernych duchowym pokarmem, swoim własnym Ciałem i swoją własną Krwią”. Wszystko zaczęło się wraz z Wcieleniem i Jezus czynił to przez całe swoje życie, aż do swej odkupicielskiej śmierci i swego zmartwychwstania. Po zmartwychwstaniu powierzył wypasanie Piotrowi, Apostołom i Kościołowi po wsze czasy.

Poprzez swych pasterzy Chrystus przekazuje swoje Słowo, rozdziela swoją łaskę w sakramentach i prowadzi swoje stado ku Królestwu: On sam oddaje siebie jako posiłek w sakramencie Eucharystii, przekazuje Słowo Boga i Jego nauki, i troskliwie prowadzi swój Lud. Jezus wystarał się dla swego Kościoła o pasterzy, podług serca, to znaczy ludzi, którzy działając w Jego osobie przez sakrament święceń, oddają swoje życie za swe owce, z miłością pasterską, w pokornym duchu służby, z łagodnością, cierpliwością i siłą. Święty Augustyn często mówił o tej wymagającej cierpliwości pasterza: “nie opuszcza mnie troska o godne spełnienie tego urzędu. (...) Choć z jednej strony przeraża mnie, że jestem dla was, z drugiej pociesza mnie to, że jestem z wami. Dla was jestem biskupem, z wami chrześcijaninem”.

I każdy z nas, chrześcijan, pracujemy wspomagając pasterzy, modlimy się za nich, miłujemy ich i jesteśmy im posłuszni. Jesteśmy również pasterzami dla braci, wzbogacając ich o otrzymane łaski i naukę, dzieląc się troskami i radościami, całym sercem pomagając wszystkim. Poświęcamy całe swoje życie tym wszystkim wśród których żyjemy, w sferze życia rodzinnego, społecznego i zawodowego, oddając życie za nich wszystkich w duchu Chrystusa, który nie przyszedł, aby Mu służyło, lecz aby służyć (Mt 20,28).

Hoy celebramos el domingo del Buen Pastor. En primer lugar, la actitud de las ovejas ha de ser la de escuchar la voz del pastor y seguirlo. Escuchar con atención, ser dóciles a su palabra, seguirlo con una decisión que compromete a toda la existencia: el entendimiento, el corazón, todas las fuerzas y toda la acción, siguiendo sus pasos.

Por su parte, Jesús, el Buen Pastor, conoce a sus ovejas y les da la vida eterna, de tal manera que no se perderán nunca y, además, nadie las quitará de su mano. Cristo es el verdadero Buen Pastor que dio su vida por las ovejas (cf. Jn 10,11), por nosotros, inmolándose en la cruz. Él conoce a sus ovejas y sus ovejas le conocen a Él, como el Padre le conoce y Él conoce al Padre. No se trata de un conocimiento superficial; se trata de una relación personal profunda, un conocimiento integral, del corazón, que acaba transformándose en amistad, porque ésta es la consecuencia lógica de la relación de quien ama y de quien es amado; de quien sabe que puede confiar plenamente.

Es Dios Padre quien le ha confiado el cuidado de sus ovejas. Todo es fruto del amor de Dios Padre entregado a su Hijo Jesucristo. Jesús cumple la misión que le ha encomendado su Padre, que es la cura de sus ovejas, con una fidelidad que no permitirá que nadie se las arrebate de su mano, con un amor que le lleva a dar la vida por ellas, en comunión con el Padre porque «Yo y el Padre somos uno» (Jn 10,30).

Es aquí precisamente donde radica la fuente de nuestra esperanza: en Cristo Buen Pastor a quien queremos seguir y la voz del cual escuchamos porque sabemos que sólo en Él se encuentra la vida eterna. Aquí encontramos la fuerza ante las dificultades de la vida, nosotros, que somos un rebaño débil y que estamos sometidos a diversas tribulaciones.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:


We know that the challenges of an unplanned pregnancy can seem insurmountable. This is especially true when it feels like there is no support for a pregnant woman struggling to appreciate the precious gift of life she carries and may compel her towards a regrettable decision. But genuine empowerment of women comes only through recognizing the dignity of the human person at every stage of life and this is most poignantly illuminated through the blessings of motherhood.

In this, it is with great joy that I announce the **FIAT Pregnancy Support Program** at Catholic Health. This program, in partnership with the Diocese of Rockville Centre, comprises a dedicated help line designed to assist women access the **counsel, resources, and encouragement needed to choose life** when facing a pregnancy with unexpected or difficult circumstances. **The Pregnancy Support Team is available 24/7, 365 days of the year** to assist callers in accessing the services needed to help them see that every new life is a blessing, even when there are challenges.

Any expectant woman in need of help can call the **FIAT Pregnancy Support Program** and be confident that, **regardless of age, religion, immigration status or ability to pay**, she will receive compassionate, non-judgmental, and **life-affirming** care. Most of all, she can be assured that she will not be alone through her pregnancy, and she will not be abandoned after she delivers her child. If she is overwhelmed by an unexpected pregnancy, contemplating abortion pills on her college campus, distressed with an adverse prenatal diagnosis, experiencing a miscarriage, worried about feeding her child, regretting a past abortion or other pregnancy-related distress, **FIAT** is there to help her sort things out and get the care she needs. It only takes the courage of a phone call to find real hope: **631-476-LOVE (5683)**.

It is my prayer that the **FIAT Pregnancy Support Program** be recognized across the Diocese of Rockville Centre as the first step a woman takes when facing challenging circumstances during pregnancy. There are promotional materials available at every parish and on-line, but we ask for your help to make this resource known widely through your prayers, your witness, and your word-of-mouth, for every one of us has an important and serious responsibility to spread the Gospel of Life. Let **FIAT** lead the way.
