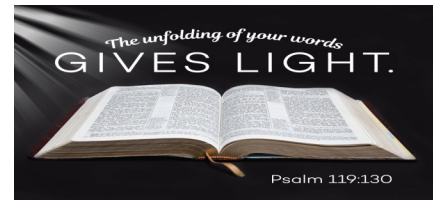

A Steward Saint...St. Peter Damian, Reformer— Saint Peter Damian’s childhood as an orphan was not an easy one. Despite this hardship, one of his brothers, a priest, looked out for him. Peter became a priest and adopted rigorous fasting and penitential practices. As a priest, Peter reformed the church and emphasized holiness and penance. He was a simple (in the best sense of the word!) and holy man. As we approach the holy season of Lent, we may be inspired by his simple daily practices of penance, such as abstaining and fasting, practices that serve to bring us closer to God. **Saint Peter Damian’s feast day is February 21.**



Reflection: Love your enemies. This is often much easier said than done! However, it must be done.

Jesus showed us this when He prayed for His persecutors. It may be easy to hate your enemy, hold on to anger, and become bitter, but God calls us to another response. “Hate the sin, but love the sinner.” God commands it for our own good.

Living Stewardship: We are grateful this week for all Christians who are able to forgive, especially in times of persecution. Their love and forgiveness provide us with the inspiration to live above hate and not be weighed down by it. *Help us, Lord, to love others as You love them.*

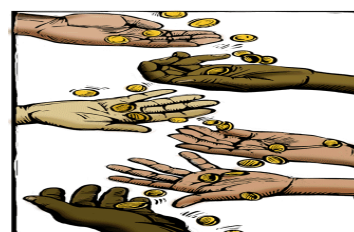
