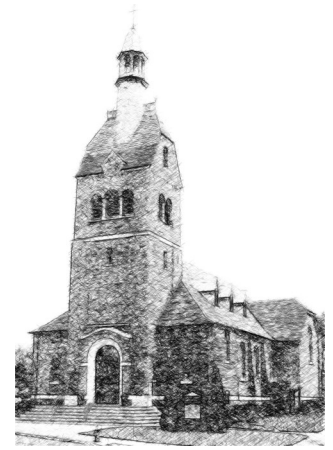

BAPTISM:

The sacrament of Baptism (English, Polish) is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th weekends of the month. Because our parish family is welcoming a new member to our faith community, Baptisms will be celebrated *during* the following Masses: 5PM Saturday vigil Mass in English, 9:30AM Polish Mass, or 11AM Mass in English. *There will be no private Baptisms.* Those chosen as Godparents must be practicing, Confirmed Catholics whose lives reflect a commitment to the Catholic faith and to the role of Godparent. *Parents must register their child prior to the Baptism.* Parents of first children are required to receive instruction. **The sacrament of Baptism (Spanish) is celebrated during the 4PM Mass on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month.** Guidelines for pre-Baptismal registration and instruction are the same for all Baptisms.

MARRIAGES:

Arrange *at least* six months before time.

DEVOTIONS:

May: Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary after each Sunday Mass

October: Decade of the Rosary after Sunday Masses

Lent: Stations of the Cross every Friday at 7:00 PM in English, 7:30 PM in Polish. Gorzkie Zale on Sundays in Lent following the 9:30AM Polish Mass.

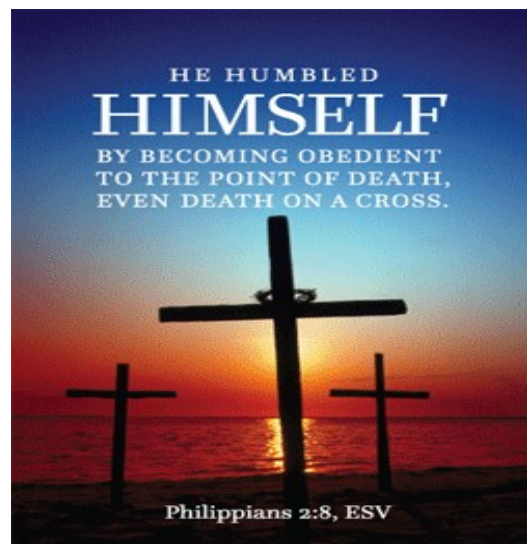

Reflections on Scripture:

The second son in today's Gospel said he would do his father's bidding, but did not. The first son balked initially but then repented and did as he was asked. *What service is God calling me to do? Which son am I more like?*

The second reading addresses two attitudes and behaviors that we are called to emulate. Saint Paul first emphasizes the need for **humility**. While we are to recognize our skills and talents as gifts from God, we are not to develop a superiority complex that leads to a self-centeredness that can sink into a disregard of others. *Do I use my God-given gifts to benefit the lives of others? Do I feel the need to outshine others?*



Are we aware of how we use the Lord's name in our everyday lives? Sadly, we hear the name that is meant to be "above every name" used today in ways that are not even remotely prayerful. God's name is used *in vain* if it is used in anger, frustration, or frivolity. By using the Lord's name inappropriately and disrespectfully, we are condoning an irreverent behavior that diminishes our spiritual health and offends those who speak of the Lord with reverence. *"Open our lips, O Lord, and our mouths shall declare Your praise."*
